The [School of Economics and Management](#) at the Faculty of Social Sciences, University of Aarhus, invites applications for a number of temporary positions as Assistant Professor (tenure track) and a number of temporary Post Doc Fellowships in Economics and in Management from August 2009 or earlier.

Subject area

This announcement is for applications within all fields of Economics and Management. In Economics, the research and teaching at the School of Economics and Management focus on theory and applications within macroeconomics, microeconomics and econometrics. In Management, research and teaching at the school focus on theory and applications within accounting, marketing, management strategy, organisation, and finance. The School of Economics and Management is also host to a number of research centres with openings within their specialized areas of interest. Positions

The assistant professorships are temporary 3 year positions with normal teaching and research responsibility in the fields of Economics and/or Management. It is expected that the successful applicants participate in the seminars, workshops and other activities at the School. The post doc positions are 1 – 2 year fellowships.
